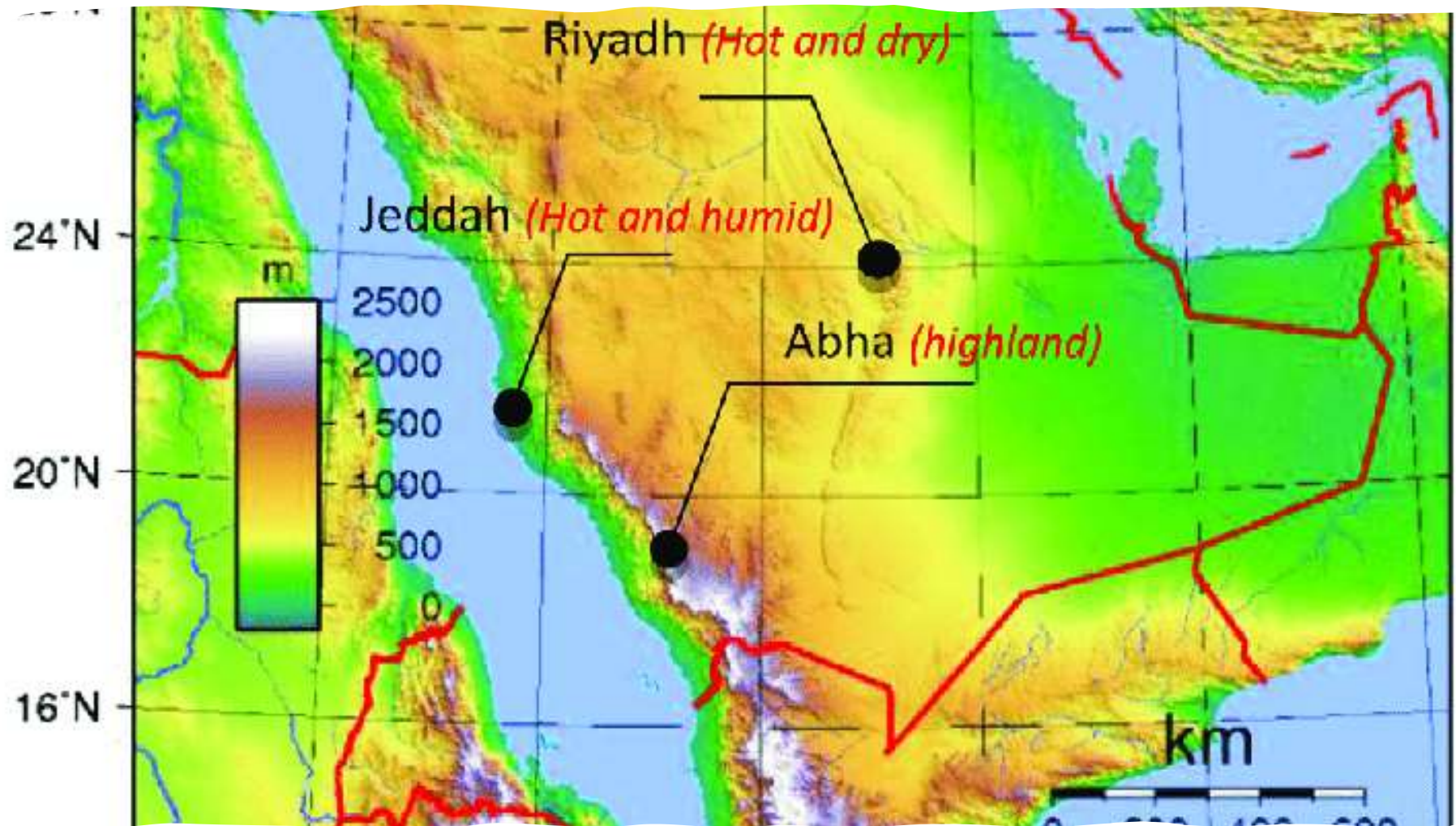

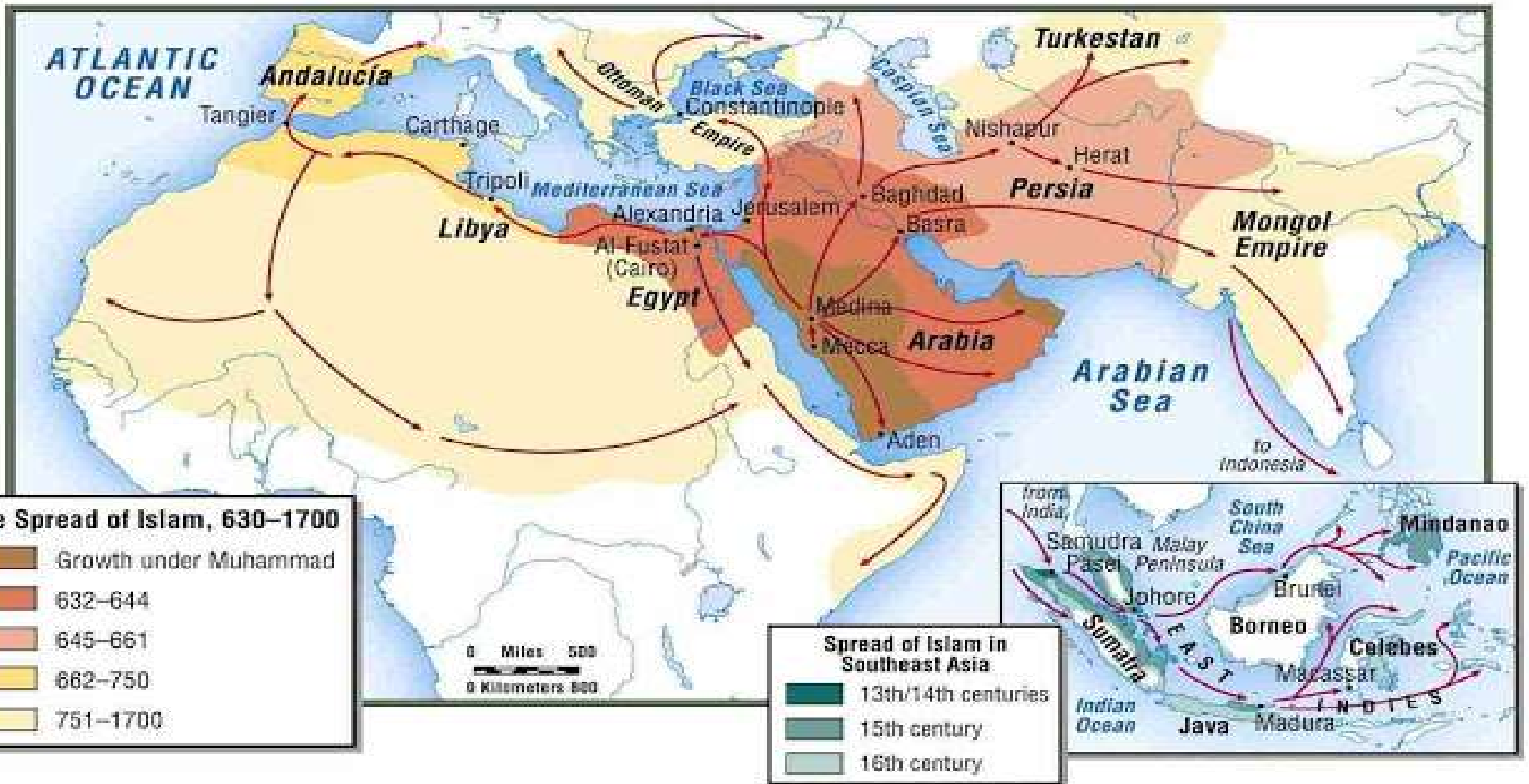




## Section 2: Split in the Islam

- After Mohammed's death – disagreement over leadership caused Islam to split into 2 main groups (Sects).

Basic Differences Between Sunni and Shi'a Muslims	
Sunni	Shi'a
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Believe that the first four caliphs were "rightly guided"</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Believe that Ali, the Prophet's son-in-law, should have succeeded Muhammad</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Believe that Muslim rulers should follow the Sunna, or Muhammad's example</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Believe that all Muslim rulers should be descended from Muhammad; do not recognize the authority of the Sunna</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Claim that the Shi'a have distorted the meaning of various passages in the Qur'an</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Claim that the Sunni have distorted the meaning of various passages in the Qur'an</li></ul>

Other	1%

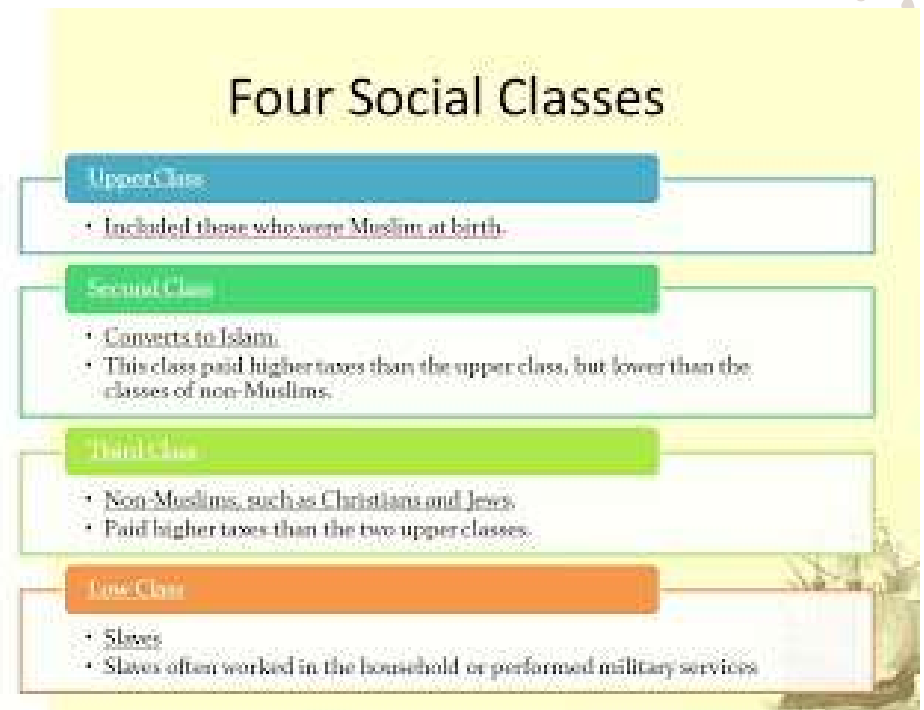

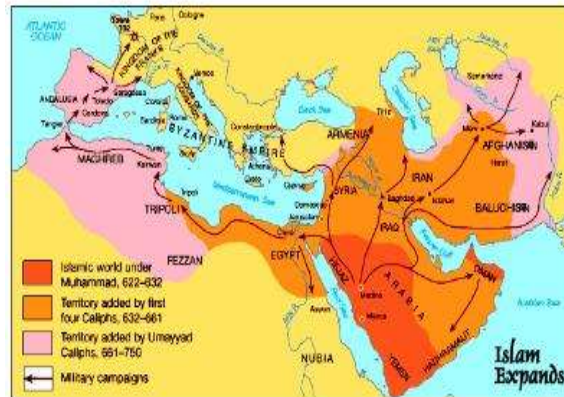
