Rich got richer: As Rome conquered more land more riches came to the city of Rome

Poor got Poorer: Rich hired slaves to do the work and poor farmers lost their land

Poor moved to the city: No jobs for them

Generals: hired the poor for their private armies and they paid the poor from their own pockets

Civil War: generals fought other generals for power

Senate: ignored the problems

What caused the civil war in the Roman Republic?

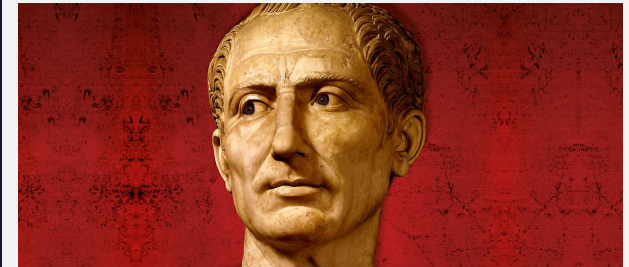
The Problems in the Roman republic

Julius Caesar: Patrician and a general who was popular

Pompey: General with an army

Crassus: Patrician with a lot of money

- This Triumvirate ruled Rome for 10 years
- Julius Caesar as consul for a 1 year out of the 10 years
- After the 1 year Julius Caesar become the governor of Gaul



Enter Julius Caesar

Define **Triumvirate**:

A group of 3
leaders

Who the 3 leaders

- **Julius Caesar left Gaul and returned to Rome**
- **He crossed the Rubicon River with his army**
- **2nd Civil war with Pompey his former ally**
- **When civil war ended he made himself dictator for life**

Who caused the fall of the Roman Republic?

Answer: Julius Caesar
